Lindiwe Shibambo - As a former domestic worker who once toiled away at her first job for R70 a month. But saw better things on the horizon. Now, 16 years later Shibambo runs her own successful company, Maid4U, an agency which has created a platforms for skills development and job creation for home employees such as domestic workers, nannies , au- pairs , home based care workers , garners , Office Cleaners , General Workers e.g Tea Ladies and those seeking house-keeping employment within local and international private residence , hotels , lodges, Retirement homes and BNBs including provision of housekeeping services to Air BNB.

She is the owner of MAID4U an agency that specialises in Recruitment, Training and Placement of Home employees, The agency also assist employers who may have employed any form of a home employees such as domestic workers, nannies, au- pairs, home based care workers, garners, Office Cleaners, General Workers e.g Tea Ladies to be compliant by offering Compliance and HR Services where they can register the employee for UIF on behalf of the employer or Activate a related Provident Fund, or Medical Aid. The agency assist employers with Basic Condition of employment Compliant Pay slip compilation, Job Description and Work Scope and Schedule Drafting as well as CCMA advisory, Consultation, Disciplinary Procedures and Hearings for home employees.

So successful has MAID4U become, thus far with placements of over 5000 Home employees, Training of more than 1500 previously disadvantage and unemployed woman who have now secured employment in within the sector. Due to its successful Business Model MAID4U has been converted into a Franchise through the Support and assistance from DTI department of Trade and Industry, Small Business Ministries, Township Micro Franchising Program, SEDA, SA Franchise warehouse and FASA.

Lindiwe Shibambo graduated at GIBS as part of the Goldman Sachs Cohort 3 of the 10 000 Woman Entrepreneurship Program, She also completed her Business Strategy and Strategy Mastery with GIBS Business School in Johannesburg South Africa, She is a Business Couch and Business Strategist as well, She completed her Coaching and Mentoring Training with Equipt Training College in Johannesburg South Africa as well, She completed her Directors Training Program with BPW and acquired her Director and Woman on Boards Certificate, The Program entailed the below modules and has ensured that Lindiwe Shibambo is board ready and can be a non executive or executive board member for any organization despite the structure, Currently she seats on 3 Boards namely LifeEdition Youth Program, SADWF Home employee Forum, Township Project and she has been appointed by the Services Seta as the Community of Expert Practitioners for the Domestic Workers Sector and seats within the Chamber Committee as an Experts, She is the Chairperson of the South African Domestic Workers Form and seats on the CCMA Tshwane Domestic Task team as an Advisor.
